I collaborate with my clients to develop pertinent and accessible evaluation processes, tools and reports, and I offer training on the collection, analysis and use of data for performance measurement. Facilitation and Knowledge Exchange

In my teaching experiences at the university and community levels, I have developed and delivered over 200 workshops, courses, trainings and webinars to varied audiences including patient groups, community service providers, students, health-care practitioners and researchers. As a facilitator, I am able to foster engaging spaces for process development and knowledge exchange. Select mandates include:

- **Creation of tailor-made trainings on program evaluation and performance measurement** offered to Canadian Parents for French, the Assemblée de la francophonie de l'Ontario, the Maison Plein Coeur, the Tables des organismes montréalais en VIH, and the Positive Leadership Development Institute
- **Delivery of trainings throughout Ontario to Francophone settlement service providers**, to increase their understanding of issues faced by LGBTQ2S+ newcomers and to build their capacity to create inclusive spaces, carried out for the Ontario Council of Agencies Serving Immigrants (OCASI)
